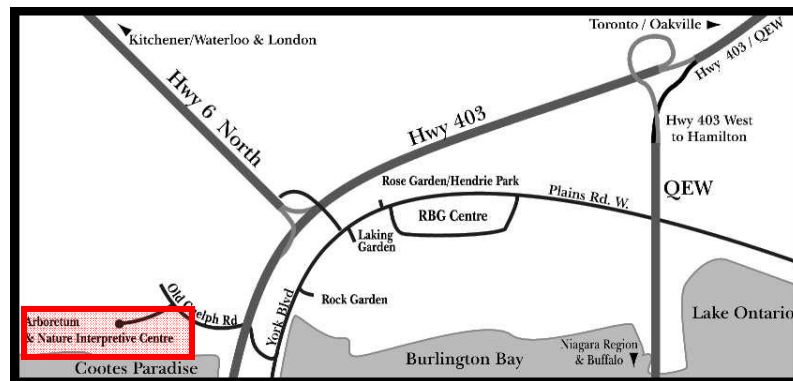

In celebration of the Hamilton Naturalists' Club's (HNC) 90th anniversary, join us for a 5 or 10 km walk along the beautiful north shore of Cootes Paradise. This location was chosen for the 2009 Nature Walk to mark early milestones in the HNC's history. In the 1920's the club drew attention to the need for protecting Cootes Paradise and played a founding role as a partner in establishing the Bruce Trail.

How to get there? Address is 16 Old Guelph Road. From Hamilton, head west on York Blvd., go past Dundurn Castle and shortly after crossing the High Level bridge take the first left turning lane onto Old Guelph Road. You will see the signs for the R.B.G. Arboretum at this turn. Travel 800 metres and the entrance is on your left. From Burlington, head west on Plains Rd. / York Blvd. and turn right onto Old Guelph Road before the High Level bridge. You will see the signs for the R.B.G. Arboretum at this turn. Travel 800 metres and the entrance is on your left. NOTE: once we confirm if the shuttle bus is operating, we'll need to include those details: For Public Transit, take the bus along Route 1BT along York/Plains Road to RBG's Laking Gardens or Headquarters where a RBG shuttle will take you to the Arboretum.
